

Yann Delacour



It is as a sculptor that Yann Delacour deals with photography. His images show environments which are very similar to organic forms in their birth, development, deform process, composition and decomposition moments. This way, mere soap bubbles become anthropomorphic forms developping themselves through and because of the wind as a first biological cell division.

Yann Delacour is interested in form's embryogenesis through very economical and precarious production processes. This precariousness aspect of his work has to be connected to the fragility of the living, the fragility of our existence.

The selfportrait series from year 2000 show deformed faces revealing a fecond cerebral world, a generic area of the imaginary. The artist thinks of himself as a body in a permanent mutation, redefining indefinitely his very own identity.

At first sight, all seems to be very unstable in Yann Delacour's work. However he succeeds in organizing a very formal and structured work, that creates both very dense and very light images, all treating about chaos of life in a minimalist aesthetic development.

Self-portraits - earth

Self-portrait is a new series of Yann Delacour's self-portraits. The head completely covered with earth, the artist seems to construct as well as deconstruct his face. What structure his identity disappear to become material in an endless process of transformation.

His artist identity is the stronger, it takes control. The physical distance between the work and the artist is here radically crushed and compressed to become a single body where material and mind are just one in a chaos questioning creation, the embryogenesis of work and the artist identity.

If we refer to the title *Untitled -Self-portrait*, which evoke at first reading a contradiction, it comes define and redefine what the artist emphasizes here with strength as a free state preidentitary. Redesign who he is, lead the artist to use black and white, which remind the drawing and the mine of lead.

Self-portraits - spheres

Untitled-Self-portraits is a series of 9 Yann Delacour's self-portraits. His head is covered by a mask under which spheres are positionned, some pits, developing differents deformations, buds or exgrowths. In every image, a light movement evoke a new state.

The artist is interested in the embryogenesis of the work, at the processus of creation, and at the intimate relation between body and the world of ideas that takes shape of a seeding.

The use of the black and the white is connected to the work of the drawing. Pits come to extend the growth of the grown-up body and so redraw at every new photographic moment.
